

In Early 2008, long-standing NC DJ/Producer/Multi-instrumentalist DJ FM was introduced to Greenville MC Big Hop by a mutual friend. Upon hearing some instrumentals which FM had put together, the duo began work on their debut EP, "Influenced" almost immediately. The EP marks significant departures in style for both artists, as FM traditionally spins and produces various styles of house ("Influenced" is a mix of hip hop and drum&bass) and Hop is known for a diverse range of hip-hop stylings, but has never delved into EDM or drum&bass. In July of 2009, the group made their debut performace at The Berkeley Cafe in Raleigh, and then again in September at The Black Flower for SPARKcon.
